Talking Points for Nazimeen/Murabbiyan Atfal

These are some points provided so that Nazimeen and Murabbiyan Atfal have a minimal idea of the message and theme of the class.

- Highlighting the importance of being a proud Ahmadi Muslim and not falling to societal pressure and an inferior complex.
- Religions from the past also been ridiculed and belittle, this isn't anything new.
- Only by Tabligh one can build confidence, taking pride as an Ahmadi will instill respect from others, and increasing your knowledge.
- The truth is the teachings of Islam is superior in every comparison and its teaching is complete.
- No matter the truth will always prevail.
- Hazrat Musleh Maud (ra) did his own research into finding out the truth and testified that he himself didn't just blindly follow the Promised Messiah (as).



Presentation Overview

Slide 2

Pose the question to the Atfal: Do you feel it is hard to be an Ahmadi Muslim, living in the USA? get their responses

Slide 3

Pose the question to the Atfal: Why do you think its hard to show our identity as an Ahmadi Muslim to others? get their response and brainstorm see how they feel in this regard

Slide 4

Ask the Atfal another question: Have you heard the word Inferiority Complex?

• It's when someone feels like they're not as good as others, even if it's not true.

Slide 5

Explain the content on the slide, highlighting that some live a double life due to being overwhelmed and the want to fit in.

Slide 6

Read the content on the slide, Highlight the point that as Ahmadi Muslim you claim to bring a spiritual revolution, how can you change others if you yourself are not about the message?

Slide 7

Pose the question: Have others from before our time fell into pressure by society?

- Ask them is this new as an Ahmadi to face?
- Have other religions gone through what we have gone?

Slide 8

Inform them of the Quranic verse and the points on the slide

- Main point to bring to attention is this isn't anything new
- in fact people faced severe persecution for their religious belief, none of us are facing such difficulty.

Slide 9

Go through the main points to overcome an inferiority complex.

- Tabligh: which is the key to becoming confident
- Be a proud Ahmadi: Huzur's (aba) quote, those who adhere to the teachings of Islam and show true qualities of righteous morals will gains people respect
- <u>Knowledge</u>: Islam's answer is superior in every comparison, never need to feel low

Explain the content of Tabligh in the slide

 another example given by Huzur (aba) is to offer congregational prayers with family on trips/public.
 People will me moved by your actions as an Muslim.

Slide 11

Read out the guidance given by Khalifatul Masih V (aba)

• Be confident since we have the truth and argument in our favor.

Slide 12

Pose the question to the Atfal and ask for their input

- Cover aspects is it wrong to question being an Ahmadi,
- If we have a doubt in our mind what should we do?

Read the quotation given by Hazrat Musleh Mau'ud (ra) Even he himself did research when it came to finding out the truth of Ahmadiyyat and not just blindly following his father the Promised Messiah (as).

Pose the question to the Atfal how can we increase our knowledge? (in regards to making sure we don't fall into a inferior complex)

Slide 15

Read the content of the slide and the saying of Huzur (aba)

- If they cant find an answer from his own research always feel free to reach to those who can ex. Your Murrabi Sahib.
- Knowledge will remove any lingering traces of an inferior complex
- Put emphasis on studying the litterature of Islam and Jamat.

Play the video: recent guidance given by beloved Huzur (aba)

Slide 17

Read the quote given by beloved Huzur (aba)

• Once again Muslims went through persecution for following the Holy Prophet (saw) and still remained by his side. We as true Muslims must always take it with honor any such difficulty given as the companions faced. Even if they don't understand and point you as an outcast, this has been done to all prophets of God, shouldn't be discourage by any hate or opinion given by anyone.

Activity: What would you do?

The takeaway of this game is to see how we should properly react given certain scenarios Ahmadi youth go through at school and with friends.

Material Required - Index cards and pen

- Depending on the attendance form small groups or individual
- Create prompt cards with prompts or scenarios
- Each group member takes a card
- Each group/Tifl will be given time to think of any ideas
- Everyone will give an answer

Prompts and Scenarios

- Taking a day off for Friday and classmates ask why?
- Class is having pizza buts its only pepperoni, your not eating. Others say to take it off how would you respond?
- Friends come over at the house and see a picture of Hudhur; they ask who is he?
- Your non-Ahmadi Muslim friend(s) are about to pray during class and they ask you to join them, how would you respond?
- You're eating (chicken/beef) and some non-Ahmadi Muslims say that is 'Haram' (not allowed), how would you respond?
- Non-Ahmadis ask you that you believe in another prophet after Holy Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) what would you say?
- Your friend asks who you are taking to Prom, how would you respond?
- Peers are pressuring you to vape with them, what would you do?
- It's Ramadan, you're fasting and your friends say not even water, what would you say?
- Friends are talking about a girl inappropriately, what would you do?
- Friends ask if you have a girlfriend, what you say?
- Friends see your mom wearing the hijab, and they ask why is she doing that? What's your response?
- Friends on Social Media sharing bad posts and share it with you, would you correct them or say something back?
