Talking Points for Nazimeen/Murabbiyan Atfal

These are some points provided so that Nazimeen and Murabbiyan Atfal have a minimal idea of the message and theme of the class.

- Financial Sacrifice is one of the hall marks of Islam
- Salat is very important for our connection to Allah, and Allah has mentioned spending in the way of Allah alongside Salat many times in the Holy Quran.
- This means that both have to be done at the same time. You cannot just give a large amount of money, and think that no Salat is needed anymore.
- Financial Sacrifice is one of the main ways through which we are able to accomplish our task of spreading the message of Islam Ahmadiyyat.
- Multiple things are supported through Ahmadi's financial sacrifices, such as MTA, Mosques, sending Missionaries all over the world, printing books and other literature, Jalsa Salana that is held in various countries, hospitals/clinics, and Jamaat schools all over the world.

Slide 2

- Pose slide question to the Atfal
- Two answers listed are the main points that are to be emphasized.
- Pose question in box to Atfal as well. Take a number of answers and request Atfal to be specific about a certain sacrifice.

Slide 3

- Post the question on the slide to the Atfal.
- The purpose is to mention a few things that are given up to achieve a goal.
- Answers such as time, money, effort, sleep, are all acceptable.

Slide 4

- Pose question to Atfal. Take a few answers from Atfal, even if it's the same answer
- Next slide contains answer

Slide 5

- Main Points: A loan is something that is paid.

Slide 6

- Pose question to Atfal, take a few answers.
- Teacher can ask Atfal if they are confused what it means to “give Allah a loan” to build up curiosity and anticipation.

Slide 7

- Ask a Tifl to read out verse and translation.
- Discuss the questions with Atfal present.
- Answers: Sacrificing in the way of Allah, trusting Allah by sacrificing your money for his sake.
- Answers for second question: Other ways you can “spend” are sacrificing those things other than money. We can spend our time for Allah sake, we can sacrifice our effort for Allah’s sake, we can sacrifice our family members (such as making our child a Waqf, or spending time away in Jamaat work), we can also “spend” our sleep by sacrificing it to do work, and/or read Tahajjud.

Slide 8

- Request a Tifl to read out Holy Qur’an verse and translation.
- Discuss two question with Atfal.

Slide 9

- Request two Atfal, each to read out the verse and translation
- Stress the point that giving Zakat is a commandment of Islam, and comes along with the command to offer Salat many times in the Quran, this shows how crucial it is.

Slide 11

- Make sure Atfal understand that these are obligations in Islam as well.
- The first is a command of the Holy Prophet (sa). Fitrana is to be given on behalf of a newborn as well.
- Fidya is found in the Holy Quran.

Slide 12

- Request a Tifl to read out the quote of the Promised Messiah (as).
- Point: Financial sacrifices allows us to achieve our goals of spreading Islam and bringing peace to the world.
- Point: The Holy Prophet (sa) would regularly request the companions for financial sacrifices as well, especially during times of battle.

Slide 13

- Request a Tifl to read the quote.
- Point: Financial Sacrifice is the battle of our day an age. It is one of the ways through which we fight Satan and un-Islamic ways of life.
- We use the financial sacrifices to spread Islam Ahmadiyyat, such as through MTA, Missionaries, publishing books, holding events, etc.

Slide 14

- Chanda is the financial sacrifice an Ahmadi gives.
- Point: The Promised Messiah (as) initiated this, we offer it out of obedience to him.

Slide 15

- Mention that there are various other ways to offer financial sacrifice, including:
 - Sadqa, which is a general charitable donation.
 - Bilal Fund: A fund established in Jama'at to support orphans
 - Maryam Fund: A fund established in Jamaat to support marriages of girls who do not have financial means to do so.





Alphabet Chain

Take Away: The purpose of this activity is to populate the minds of the Atfal with a review of the topic at hand with a light but competitive game.. This generating of words can help in creating a culture in the mind that solidifies the information presented.

Instructions

- Begin with one Tifl and ask him to say any one word regarding the topic and presentation.
- The next Tifl must say another word with the last letter of the previous word.
 - Ex: Tifl would begin the game by saying the word “Financial”, the next Tifl would have to say a related work to the topic beginning with “F”, such as “Fidya”, then next Tifl would have to say a word beginning with “A”, such as “Allah”.
- Continue this chain until last Tifl is left.
- Give 20 seconds to each Tifl to come up with a word.
- Additionally: Atfal can be divided up into teams of two or three if there is larger attendance and time needs to saved.
