Talking Points for Nazimeen/Murabbiyan Atfal

These are points provided in the slides so that Nazimeen and Murabbiyan Atfal have a minimal idea of the message and theme of the class.

- The Holy Quran is our primary guiding light, without it we cannot live a life that follows Allah the best.
- The Holy Quran is not man made. This should interest us as we should want to know what these words from the creator of the heavens and earth mean.
 - Create interest in the Atfal that as they find interest in fiction, they have something that is literally not of this world.

Slide 1

- Title Slide

Slide 2

- Main Point: To show that the Holy Quran is a book that is not from any human, and build interest in it as something not of this earth.
- Discussion question is meant to generate ideas of 'why we like these fantasy'
- We like to spend time in those things that are not of this world. They fascinate us, stretch our imagination, and make us feel exceptional.
- The Quran is also not of this world, no human has made it, we should have an interest that "Where did it come from?" and "What does it say?"

Slides 3

- Take a few answers from the Atfal.
- Main Points: The Holy Qur'an is **real**. It is from Allah Almighty himself, while everything else is a fictional human creation.
- We create new worlds again and again, (Star Wars, Call of Duty, Comic Books), but the Holy Quran always feels new because Allah has given it that quality.
- The stories in these movies and books are not real, but the stories in the Holy Quran are real.

Slide 4-5

- Pose question to the Atfal.
- Answer is on next slide.
- The Holy Quran is meant to be recited and pondered over. The name also shows that we have to do it again and again, and not stop after we finish it the first time.

Slide 6

- Ask a Tifl to read out the Quran verse, and its translation
- If we do not ponder over the Quran, then it places a lock on our hearts.
- You have to reflect about the Quran with our heart, This means we have to be following Allah's teaching - being kind, respecting parents, doing Salat, and working hard.
 - These things will make our hearts cleaner, and it will allow us to think with the

Slide 7-8

- Pose Question to Atfal and get a few answers.
- Next slide has the answer. Request a Tifl to read a verse along with translation.

Slide 9

- Next slide will show that Allah has made the Quran easy, but this is to get the Atfal mentioning if they think it is difficult, and then showing how it can be easy for them.

Slide 10/11

- Allah has revealed the Quran ‘piecemeal’, meaning it is mean to be taken in sections, and over time.
- Young Atfal may look at the Quran as a whole, or blocks of text of Arabic and get scared.
- This verse teaches that you have to read in sections, and “pieces,” and not be scared of the whole block.
- An example is shown on next slide.

Slide 11

- We should read the Quran by looking at in “pieces,” it makes it easier to read and understand.

Slide 12

- **Questions to Atfal:** Have you noticed that the Quran is much easier to memorize as compared to English text?
- Allah has designed the Quran where it gets easier for us to pick it up.

Slide 13

- Request a Tifl to recite the verse along with translation.
- In our Ijtema'at and other Jama'at functions, we should be quiet and listen to the recitation of the Quran.
- This opens up the doors of Allah's mercy.

Slide 14

- Request a Tifl to read the Hadith.
- The Holy Prophet (sa) enjoyed listening to the Quran as well, so we should also try to enjoy it.

Slides 15

- Request Tifl to read out Hadith.
- Every single letter of the Quran gives us immense blessings.
- This should motivate us to read it even more, since Allah rewards for even the smallest of matters

Slides 16

- **Question: What does it mean to “return” back with the Quran?**
- Life is a journey, and we all have to return back to Allah at the end of this journey.
- Allah has given us guidance so that we can live the best life by following his commands.
- Returning with the Quran means we tried to read, learn, and follow the Quran to the best of our ability.

Instructions
