Talking Points for Nazimeen/Murabbiyan Atfal

These are some points provided so that Nazimeen and Murabbiyan Atfal have a minimal idea of the message and theme of the class.

- Importance of Marriage and Nikkah: are when who's morals are protected and like a fortress; where as the man is the protector and the women come into the protection of that fort.
- In a world filled with distractions, temptations, and harmful behaviors, marriage provides a protective framework, helping you focus on what truly matters Building a future that pleases Allah.
- What do we look for in a partner Righteousness.
- Both must think in these terms that their actions should be aimed at pleasing Allah. When that becomes the goal, then both spiritual advancement and mutual love become possible
- Be like the Holy Prophet (saw) perfect example of a husband.

Slide 2

Read the following verse of the Holy Quran, if possible try to explain its importance

Slide 3

Pose the question to the Atfal: What's so important about marriage? And having a wife? - explain why is there a marriage why our parents are married, what's its purpose.

Slide 4

Read the following two Hadith of the Holy Prophet (saw), explain this is the Sunnah of the Holy Prophet (saw) which is our purpose.

Slide 5

Explain the content on the slide, highlighting that its purpose to enable a relationship and be together, to produce progeny and work on their upbringings, to make such relation or union which protects against sin and wickedness.

Slide 6

Pose the question to Atfal: What does Nikkah mean?

• Nikah is the marriage between a man and women in Islam

Slide 7

Explain the slide the purpose of Marriage

• Importance of Marriage and Nikkah: are when who's morals are protected and like a fortress; where as the man is the protector and the women come into the protection of that fort.

Slide 8

Read the slide, highlight the importance of building a future that pleases Allah - true purpose of our marriage

Slide 9

Pose the question to the Atfal: What should we look for in a partner?

Slide 10

Read the hadith of the Holy Prophet (saw) explaining that the best quality is her righteousness, all those other qualities are never fulfilling. Such as her beauty, when you look at her beauty know that her beauty can change, turn old and not serve as an attraction. What truly makes a healthy relationship is her character.

Slide 11 - 12

Read out the content from Beloved Huzoor (aba) - Highlighting that seeking Allah's pleasure in a relationship will make a relationship healthy. When that is in mind you become cautious in remembering the spouses rights and needs.

Slide 13

Pose the question to Atfal: How was the Holy Prophet (saw) treatment towards his wives?

Slide 14

Highlight the three conducts of the Holy Prophet (saw) to the Atfal.

• Encourage them to fulfill that example

Slide 15

Pose the question to the Atfal: When you look in the mirror can you see your future self?

• Ask them if they can be that example of the Holy Prophet (saw)

Slide 16

Remind them the person we marry will influence your children and read the content on the slide.

 Very important to keep in mind that if you want your progeny to be righteous then you must try to be that example and marry a person who has such qualities of righteousness that your children will be in safe hands

Slide 17

Read the Hadith of the Holy Prophet (saw), when a person passes his children can still pray for him to elevate his status.

Slide 18

Pose the question to Atfal: What Dua Does the Holy Qur'an Teach Us for a Righteous Wife and Children?

Slide 19

Read the Dua encourage to be memorized as well

Activity

Take Away: The purpose of this activity is to encourage students to write to Beloved Huzoor (aba) and build this habit of writing.

Write a letter to beloved Huzoor (aba)

Instructions

Hand out blank pieces of paper and pen to each student and make sure they have something to write on (e.g. clipboard)

Atfal should write prayers to Huzoor (aba), inform Huzoor (aba) one new thing about themselves they have done and prayers for further success in their lives and future
