






# WHAT DOES ISLAM SAY ABOUT RESPECTING

### LET'S SEE WHAT THE HOLY QUR'AN SAYS:

"Thy Lord has commanded, 'Worship none but Him, and [show] kindness to parents. If one of them or both of them attain old age with thee, never say unto them any word expressive of disgust nor reproach them, but address them with excellent speech. And lower to them the wing of humility out of tenderness. And say, 'My Lord, have mercy on them even as they nourished me in my childhood'"


(Surah Bani Isra'il, Ch.17: V.24-25)

### POINTS TO TAKE FROM THE HOLY QURAN

In these verses, it talks about Allah: 'to worship Him' - but after that, it talks about parents:

- to show kindness to them,
- **not** to say any word against them,
- **not** to reproach (admonition) them,
- to address them with excellent speech,
- to show humility to them,
- and to pray for them.

# THE HOLY PROPHET (SAW) SAID



"The happiness of God lies in the happiness of parents and God is also unhappy when parents are unhappy."

### THE PROMISED MESSIAH (AS) SAID

"I truthfully proclaim that a person who is not dutiful to their mother and father will never receive goodness and blessing.

So mould yourselves with good intentions to act upon the instructions of God and His Messenger with complete obedience and loyalty;

for all good lies in this, otherwise, one is free to act as they please. My duty is only to advise you."



### WHY IS IT IMPORTANT IN ISLAM? LETS SEE:

Hazrat Abu Umamah narrated that once a man asked the Holy Prophet (saw) about the rights of parents upon their children. He replied that: 'The parents are the Heaven or Hell for their children.'

Once a person came to Holy Prophet (saw) and sought his advice about taking part in Jihad with him. The Holy Prophet (saw) asked him whether his mother was alive? He answered 'yes! The Holy Prophet (saw) then told him 'Go back home and serve her as Heaven was under her feet.'

Hazrat Abdullah Bin Amr narrates that the Holy Prophet (saw) said: 'The pleasure of Allah lies in the pleasure of father and displeasure of Allah lies in the displeasure of father.'

Hazrat Abu Hurairah narrates: The Holy Prophet (saw) cursed the person three times whose old parents (both or one) were alive and he still did not earn Heaven (by serving them).

# GIVING TO YOUR PARENTS

Once a man complained to the Holy Prophet (saw) about his father who took his belongings whenever he liked.

The Messenger of Allah called for his father, who was a very old man, and asked him the details of the matter.

The father said, 'O, Messenger of Allah, a time was when my son was weak and helpless and bare-handed while I had strength and wealth. I never hesitated to give him my belongings whenever he needed them. Today I am weak and bare-handed while he is rich and now he keeps his belongings from me!

Hearing this, tears came to the eyes of the Holy Prophet (saw) and he said to the son: 'You and your belongings belong to your father!'

# EXAMPLE OF HAZRAT AMMA JAN (RA)

(WIFE OF THE PROMISED MESSIAH (AS))

The Promised Messiah (as) said: "Once our daughter had cholera. At home, my wife would take all her vomit and such on her hands. The mother is the child's partner in all sufferings. This is a natural love that no other love can compete with. It is to this that God Almighty has indicated in the Holy Qur'an:

'Verily, Allah requires you to abide by justice, and to treat with grace, and give like the giving of kin to kin!' (The Holy Qur'an, 16:91)

We learn from the Hadith that when a person dies, all his deeds end except three, and one of them is:


'A righteous child who prays for him.' (Sahih Muslim)

TAKEAWAY. Each Tifl shares one personal moment of respecting parents/elders that turned out good for them.

- A moment you served or helped your parents/elders.
- A time you disagreed but still showed respect.
