
An Introduction to the Financial System of the

What are some of the Financial Schemes in the Jama'at?

Waqf-e-Jadi

Imams, who then teach children about religion,
Quran and inform others about the beautiful message of Islam.

Wassiyat:

making a will of donating 1/10 to 1/3 of your wealth to the Jamaat at the time of one's death. Funds are used for propagation of Islam, publishing religious books, helping orphans, poor and needy people.

Atfal Chanda:

(Mandatory for all Atfal)

Eid Fund:

the practice of offering Eid fund exists since the time of Promised Messiah^(as). The purpose is so that as a person spends money on clothes, food, gatherings and gifts etc., on all happy occasions like Eid, one should bear in mind the requirements of faith and religion.

Chanda Jalsa Salana:

An obligatory donation [chanda] towards all sorts of

expenses in connection with preparation and holding of Jalsa Salana, the annual

convention.
