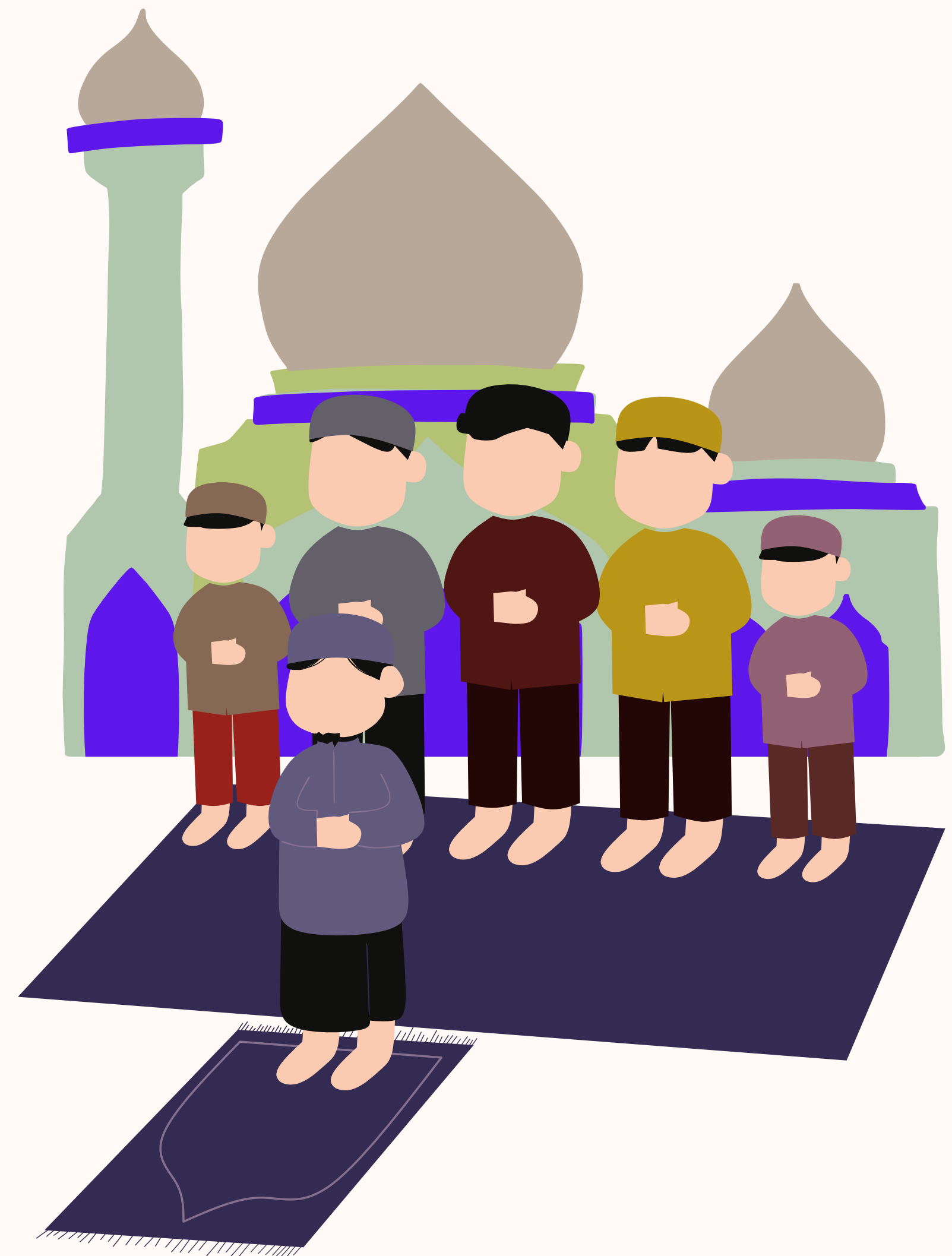
Select one Tifl to face the rest of the Atfal. This Tifl cannot look at the screen.

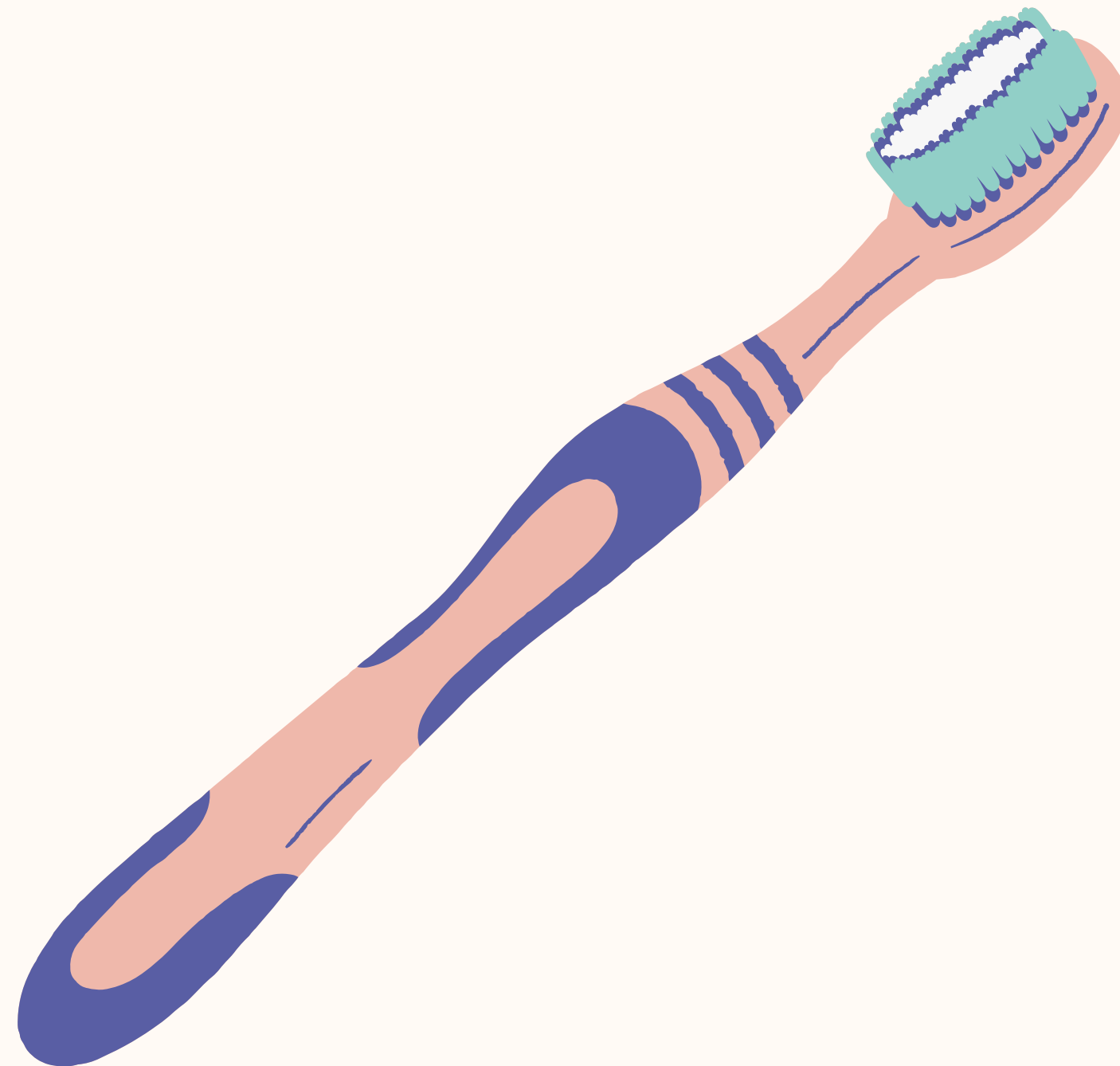


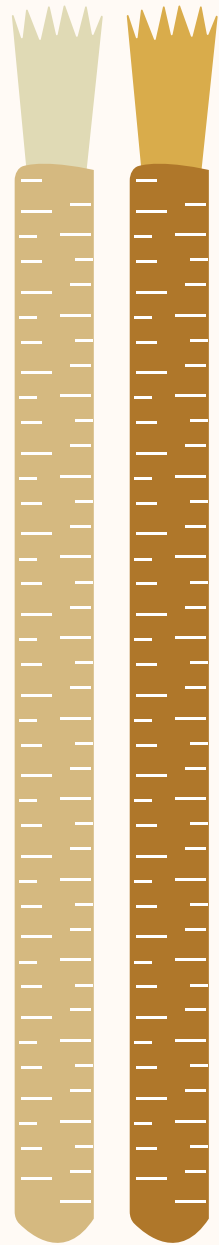

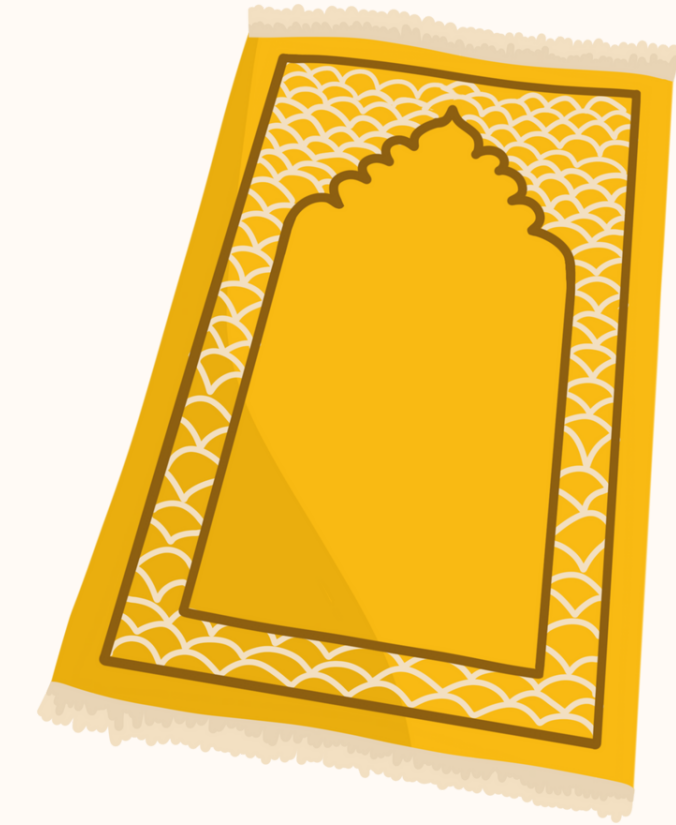
Miswak

Similar function to a toothbrush
and flosser.

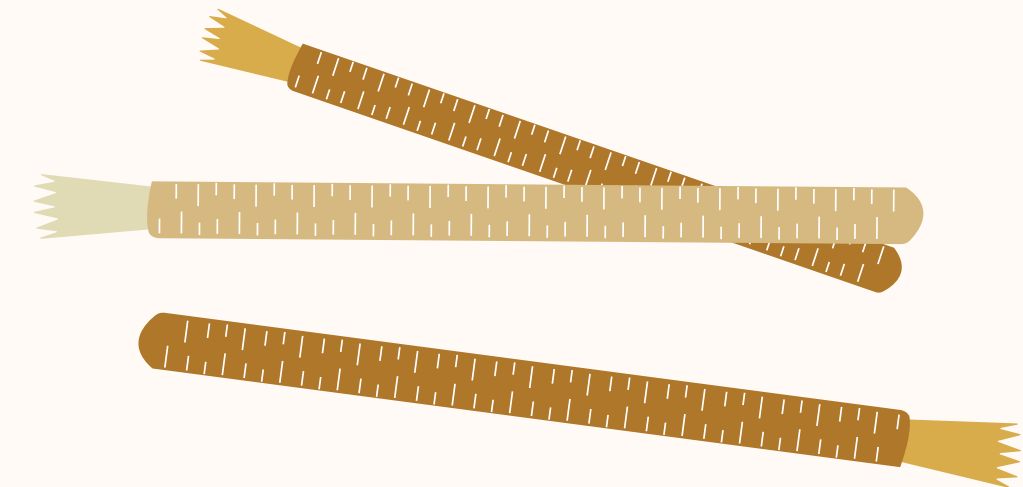
Made from the twigs of a specific
tree called "Arak."

"Whenever the Holy Prophet (sa) used to get up at night for Tahajjud, he used to clean his mouth with Siwak (miswak).

(Sahih Bukhari, Book of Ablution)



"If it were not difficult for my nation, I would command them to use the siwak (miswak) before every prayer." (Tirmidhi, Book of Purification)

The people used to come from their abodes and from Al-`Awali (i.e. outskirts of Medina up to a distance of four miles or more from Medina).

They used to pass through dust and used to be drenched with sweat and covered with dust; so sweat used to trickle from them. One of them came to Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) who was in my

house. The Prophet (ﷺ) said to him, "I wish that you keep yourself clean on this day of yours (i.e. take a bath)."
